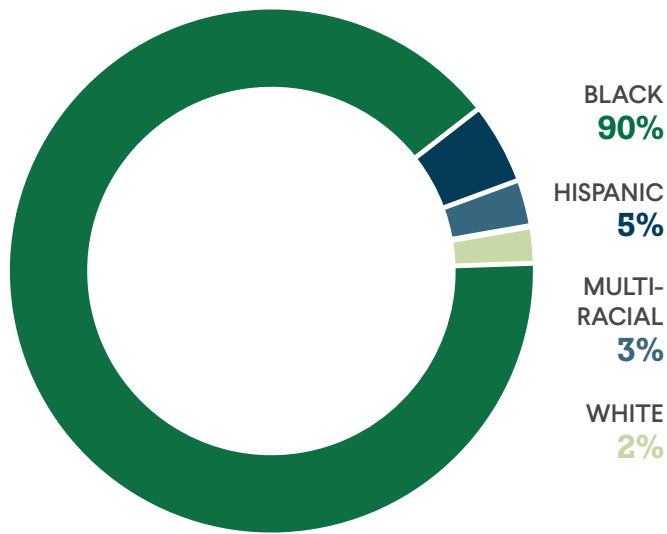

## STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

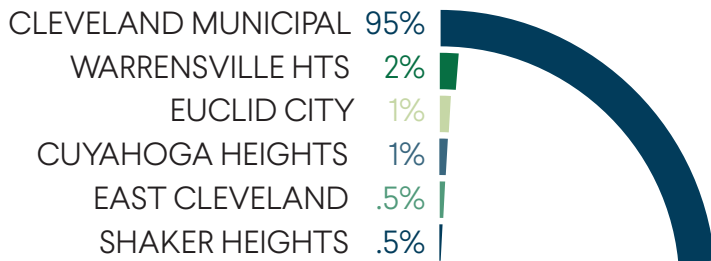

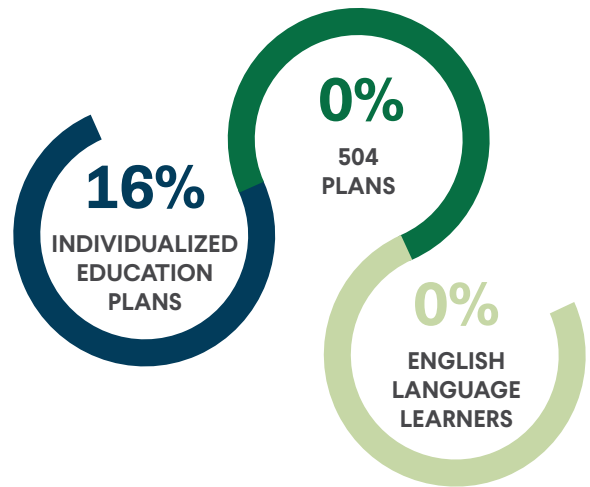

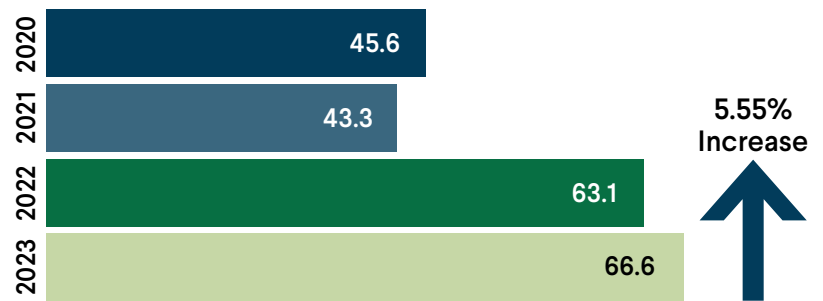
## ACADEMIC PROGRESS

The academic goals of The Broadway Academies for the 2022-23 school year were for

- Grades K-5: Meet end of year average growth target in Math (i-Ready)
- Grades 6-8: Demonstrate growth or proficiency in Math (i-Ready)

The school exceeded their academic goals as well as the expectations of the state of Ohio as evidenced by a 4-star Overall rating. Additionally, the school increased its Performance Index (PI) score by over 5%. ### YOY PERFORMANCE INDEX SCORE



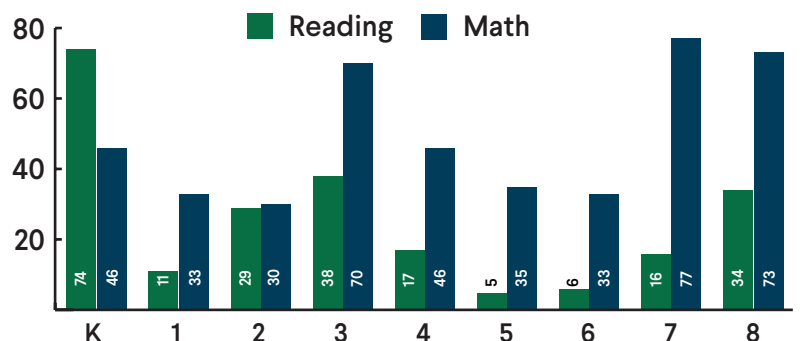

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance.
